**Narrator:** Once upon a time there were three little pigs.

**Three little pigs (dancing and singing):** Who's afraid of the big bad wolf, the big bad wolf, the big bad wolf,  
Who's afraid of the big bad wolf, tralalalalala...

**Narrator:** One day the three little pigs wanted to go out into the wide world to seek their fortunes.

**First little pig:** I'm going to build me a house of straw.  
**Second little pig:** I'm going to build me a house of sticks.  
**Third little pig:** I'm going to build me a house of bricks.



**Narrator:** Then, along came the big bad wolf.

**Big bad wolf:** Little pig, little pig, let me in.

**First little pig:** No, no, not by the hair on my chinny chin chin. I'll not let you in.

**Big bad wolf:** Then I'll huff and I'll puff and I'll blow your house down.

*(The big bad wolf blows the house of straw down. The first little pig runs to the house of the second little pig.)*

**Big bad wolf:** Little pig, little pig, let me in.

**Second little pig:** No, no, not by the hair on my chinny chin chin. I'll not let you in.

**Big bad wolf:** Then I'll huff and I'll puff and I'll blow your house down.

*(The big bad wolf blows the house of sticks down. Both pigs run to the house of the third little pig.)*

**Big bad wolf:** Little pig, little pig, let me in.

**Third little pig:** No, no, not by the hair on my chinny chin chin. I'll not let you in.

**Big bad wolf:** Then I'll huff and I'll puff and I'll blow your house down.





*(The Big bad wolf tries and tries, but cannot blow the house of bricks down. Then he starts to climb down the chimney. The pigs heat a pot of boiling water for the wolf. The wolf falls down the chimney and into the pot of boiling water. The Big bad wolf rolls on the floor in pain.)*

**Three little pigs (singing and dancing around the wolf):** Who's afraid of the big bad wolf, the big bad wolf, the big bad wolf, Who's afraid of the big bad wolf, tralalalalala...
