Narrrator: Then, along came the big bad wolf.

down.

(The big bad wolf blows the house of straw down. The first little pig runs to the house of the second little pig.)

Big bad wolf: Little pig, little pig, let me in.

Second little pig: No, no, not by the hair on my chinny chin chin. I'll not let you in.

Big bad wolf: Then I'll huff and I'll puff and I'll blow your house down.

(The big bad wolf blows the house of sticks down. Both pigs run to the house of the third little pig.)

Big bad wolf: Little pig, little pig, let me in.

Third little pig: No, no, not by the hair on my chinny chin chin. I'll not let you in.

Big bad wolf: Then I'll huff and I'll puff and I'll blow your house down.



(The Big bad wolf tries and tries, but cannot blow the house of bricks down. Then he starts to climb down the chimney. The pigs heat a pot of boiling water for the wolf. The wolf falls down the chimney and into the pot of boiling water. The Big bad wolf rolls on the floor in pain.)

Three little pigs (singing and dancing around the wolf): Who's afraid of the big bad wolf, the big bad wolf, the big bad wolf, Who's afraid of the big bad wolf, tralalalalala...
